### **Guidelines:**

Demonstrations <u>do not need to be accompanied by a paper submission</u> to IWBF 2020, although this is encouraged. Decisions on demonstration proposals are independent from the decision on any submitted paper. Demonstrations linked to already published articles and/or performed in previous events are also acceptable.

The organising committee will provide one table, one A0-sized poster board, one power outlet, and wi-fi connectivity to each demonstration. <u>Authors are expected to bring any other needed equipment, and should mention any special requirements</u> in the submitted proposal document.

Please note that demonstrations should focus on research aspects (methods, systems or applications). Demonstrations focused on business visibility will be rejected. Institutions looking for marketing or sales opportunities should contact the sponsorship chairs.

## **Submission:**

Interested parties should submit a short proposal document (maximum 2 pages) including:

- (1) a short abstract describing the demonstration: the methods/systems, their context, goals, and results;
- (2) reference to submitted manuscripts or publications associated with the demonstration (if any);
- (3) a list of needed space/facilities/equipment not brought by the authors;
- (4) pictures or schematics of the demonstration setup (optional);
- (5) a list of previous conferences/events where the demonstration was performed, and any changes made since then.

Authors should follow carefully all instructions and guidelines and submit a demo-proposal document in the IEEE conference style and use the respective template. Proposals must be submitted in PDF format using the Microsoft CMT submission system.
